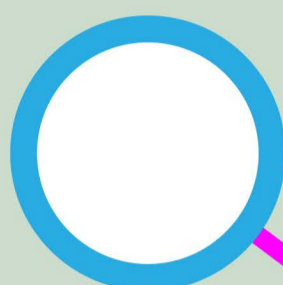


# Your Fast Track to a Flying Career

## Start Training

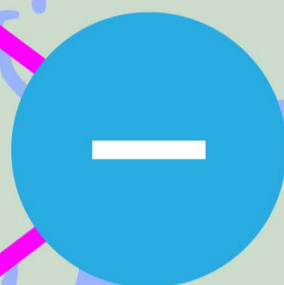
Perform regular flight and ground instruction lessons with an instructor at GPTC.



The FAA Requires students to gain 40 hours of flight time before their PPL. Most people take from 60-80 hours.

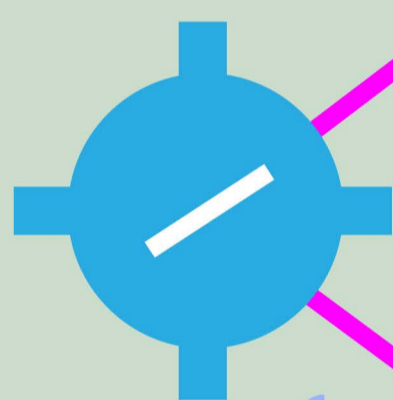
## Private Pilot's License (PPL)

The first step. Allows flying under visual flight rules (VFR).



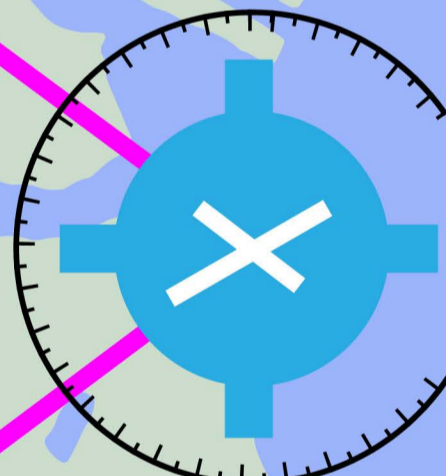
## Instrument Rating

The instruments in the plane and in the Air Traffic Control (ATC) System.



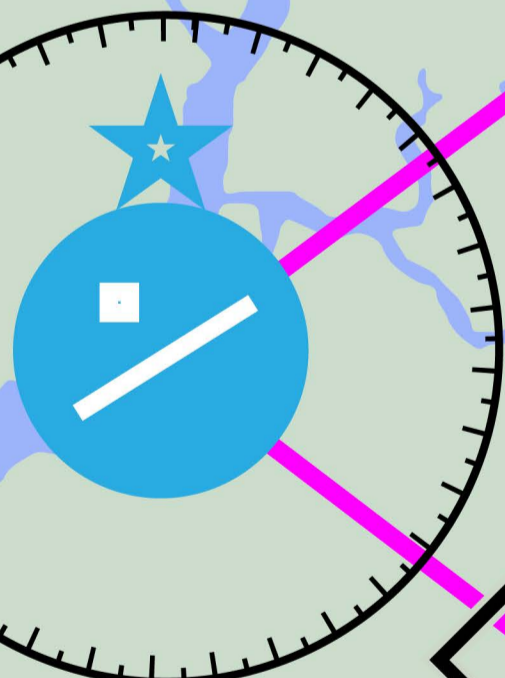
## Commercial Rating

Fly a more complex aircraft and make money as a pilot.



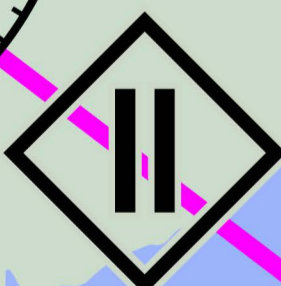
## Certified Flight Instructor (CFI)

Train students pilots and earn income while gaining experience.



## CFII

Fly with students obtaining their instrument rating.



Pilots must earn 1500 hours of flight time to qualify for airline employment.

## Professional Pilot

Career-ready aviator with all ratings and 1500 hours of flight time.
